Livia Daggett's essay, titled "I'm the child of scientists. I find the global disenchantment with the humanities worrying," was written in COMP 560 Writing Arguments with Professor Moriah Kirdy. The essay brilliantly pairs a narrative of personal discovery with larger cultural trends. In vivid detail, the reader gets a glimpse at Livia's personal journey from a home life steeped in scientific inquiry to their decision to pursue a liberal arts path in their own education. Livia's personal journey intersects with cultural trends in the opposite direction: where more and more students seem to be abandoning the humanities in favor of more lucrative careers in science and technology. Livia's refocused lens: *whither the humanities in higher education?*
